Most Humble Heart of St. Joseph, Pray for us


PRAYER TO ST. MARTIN DE PORRES

DID YOU KNOW?

A PLENARY INDULGENCE (complete remission of temporal punishment due to sin)...may be gained once a day (except by those who are in danger of death):

- When the Rosary is prayed in Church, in a family group or in a religious community.
- Also, 5 Rosary decades must be prayed continuously.
- The prayers of the Rosary must be prayed vocally and one must meditate upon the Mysteries of the Rosary.
- In public recitation, the Mysteries of the Rosary must be announced.

IN ADDITION, to gain a plenary indulgence, three other conditions must be fulfilled:

- A sacramental confession
- Eucharistic Communion
- Prayers for the Pope's intentions

If all the above conditions are not fulfilled the indulgence is only partial. Both a plenary and partial indulgence may be applied to the dead.
